Contact with confirmed positive COVID-19 case without wearing PPE



Contact with suspected but not tested COVID-19 case (or second degree exposure)



No known contact but with symptoms



Quarantine for 14 days from day of exposure and watch for symptoms.

Are you experiencing symptoms?



Respiratory



Fever



Gastrointestinal



Continue working with PPE but must report any symptoms to leadership within the next 14 days.

If no symptoms, return to work in 14 days.

As you recover, you may return to work with strict PPE use.

Must take leave and return to work 72 hours after recovery with strict PPE use.



Mandatory influenza, RSV, and COVID-19 testing.

Positive for COVID-19



Positive for flu or other respiratory virus



RCM performs contact tracing and notifies patients of exposure.

If unable to acquire testing, wait 72 hours after recovery to return to work with strict PPE use.
