## ASYEMMTRY

One half of your suspicious spot or mole is unlike the other.

## BORDER

The spot or mole has an irregular, scalloped or poorly defined border.

#### COLOR

The spot or mole has varying colors such as shades of tan, brown, black, or areas of white, red, or blue.



## $\mathsf{D}$

### DIAMETER

While melanomas are usually great than 6mm, or about a pencil eraser, when diagnosed early they can be smaller.

You have been monitoring a spot or mole on your body and noticed that it has evolved over time in size, shape, or color.
